Town and State of Virginia do Make and ordain this my last will and Testament
in the manner and form following Viz

1. I Give unto my sister Dorothy Denny the tract of land whereon I now live with all the appurtenances belonging therunto also Solly and Stephens to her and to her heirs
2. To my Niece Anna Holcomb I Give Robinson and Ginny to her and to her heirs forever
3. To my Niece Melisa F. Nicholson I Give Peter Edward and Mary Ann to her and to her heirs forever
4. To my Niece Catharine W. Cobb I Give John and Sophia to her and to her heirs forever
5. To my Niece Anna M. White I Give Oliver to her and to her heirs forever
6. To my Niece Sarah F. Cobb I Give William and Nancy to her and to her heirs forever
7. To my Niece Margaret F. Cobb I Give Friedrich and Judy to her and to her heirs forever
8. It is my will and desire that the Remaining part of my Estate not heretofore disposed of shall be sold and after my last debts and funeral expenses are Paid the balance of the money to be Equally divided amongst the above Named legates
9. I do hereby constitute and appoint my friend Benjamin Denny Executor to this my last will and Testament hereby Revoking all other and former Wills by me heretofore made In Testimony Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 15 day of October 1844
