Two cups and saucers one set of cards two horses four beds of my one side board one chest one pair of best watches first chairs and Agnes Maud Gilbert's one brass chest
3^d I Give at the death of my Daughter Caroline Drakes to my two grand Daughters Emily Angala Drakes & Mary Caroline Drakes Agnes Maud Gilbert to them & their heirs forever at the death of my Daughter Caroline "I wish the property named her sole except Agnes Gilbert and equally divided between my Grand children there living"
4th I Give and bequeath to my two Grand sons David Sumner Drakes and Francis Maud Drakes two beds second chair & furniture to them & their heirs forever
5th I Give and bequeath to my Grand son John Henry Drakes one bed and furniture of his choice to him and his heirs forever
6th I Give and bequeath to my Grand Daughters Emily Angala Drakes & Mary Caroline Drakes two beds & furniture to them and their heirs forever first & second chairs
7th All the Property that I have not disposed of above I wish sold and after all my debts are paid I want the balance equally divided between my Grand children I also appoint Richard Barrett my Executor Signed under my hand and seal the eighteenth day of June one thousand eight hundred and forty Four.
