I Give and Lastly I hereby name Now and appoint my friend David Barrott my Executor to this my last will and Testament avowing all former wills by me made and acknowledge this to be my last will and Testament Given under my hand the 23 day of August one thousand eight hundred and forty four

At a Court held for the County of Southampton on the 21st day of October 1844. This Last will and Testament of Patience Reed a/w was proved by the oaths of David Barrott, Richard J Vick two of the subscribing witnesses thereto and entered to be Recordary. And on the Motion of David Barrott the Executor therein named who made oath and together with Benjamin J Barrott & David Biggins his associates entered into and acknowledged a bond in this penalty of two thousand dollars Conditioned as the law directs Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate of the said will in due form.

In the Name of our Amen I Benjamin Sniffen of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia being old and my health feels best of sound mind and memory thanks be unto God for the same I do now think proper to make this paper writing as and for my last will and Testament in manner and form following (to wit) "

I Give my will and desire is that all my just debt's to be paid out of the money due me together with my Negro woman Margilla and her child Madison to be sold to apaid in paying my debts and if that is not sufficient to pay all my debts & some security money which I except my Estate to have to pay I wish enough of my property that can be best disposed to be sold for that purpose."

I Give I Give unto my beloved wife Frances Sniffen for and during her Natural life the following property all of my Lands lying South of the Spring branch together with the following Negroes Sam. Amos, Lucy, and other three feather beds and furniture one Gray horse two cows & calves two swine and pigs four sheeps six head of sheep one Cart & wheels one Sigs one Sigs of corn and as much of my household and kitchen furniture as will be needful for her use and as many of my farming tools as will be needful to carry on the farm all the above property I lend to my wife for and during her Natural life"

I Give I Give and bequeath to my son-in-law Thos J White who marries my daughter Margarett one bond which he owes me amounting to about two hundred dollars beside what I have heretofore given him to him & his heirs forever

I Give I Give and bequeath unto my daughter Eliza Adams three hundred Dollars to be raised out of the sale of my land lying in the western district of Tennessee which I wish to be sold at my death by my Executor this I Give to her and her heirs forever in addition to what I have heretofore given her"
