At a Court held for the County of Southampton on the 19 day of November 1844 This Last will and Testament of Margaret Wilson dec^d was proved by the oaths of John E. Beale & Benj. E. Daughton the subscribing witnesses thereof and ordered to be Recorded: and on the Motion of Thomas B. Maxwell the Executor therein named who made oath and together with Robert F. Barnes and John E. Beale his solicitor entered into and acknowledged as being in the penalty of one thousand dollars conditions as the law directs Certificate is granted him for Stamping & probate of said will in due form

all of my crop of brandy some peas fodder shucks &c all of my house hold and kitchen furniture of every description and all of my farming utensils to her and her heirs forever

3^d I leave to my beloved wife Nancy Bayhine during the term of her Natural life my gins Mills my two steel caps and worms all my lands and all my Negro slaves not named above in the second item of this my last will and Testament

4th at the death of my beloved wife Nancy Bayhine I Give to the children of my friend James B. Vugthorpe the one half of the above named Negro slaves referred to in the third item of this my last will and Testament with their increase to them and their heirs forever

5th at the death of my friend James B. Vugthorpe & his estate in them the said Negro slaves reserving however to my friend James B. Vugthorpe son of Simon Bayhine deceased the one half of the above

being the other half of the said named Negro slaves referred to in the third item of this my last will and Testament with their increase to them and their heirs forever reserving however to my friend John Bayhine son of Simon & his estate in them the said Negro
