This last will and testament of Margaret Wilson as was proved by the oaths of John E. Peale  
& Mary E. Daugherty the subscribers witnesses thereto and sworn to be Recorded: and on the  
action of Thomas B. Morell the Executor thereon named who made oath and together with Robert  
S Morris and John E. Peale his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty  
of one thousand dollars conditions as the law directs testifying he grants him for staining  
of said will in due form.

In the Name of God Amen. I Shadrach Boykin of the County of Smithington  
and State of Virginia do make and ordain my last will and testament in manner  
and form following that is to say:

1. After the payment of my just debts I give to my beloved wife Nancy Boykin all  
the money Bonds accounts or claims I may have at my death to her and her heirs forever.  
I give to my beloved wife Nancy Boykin the following Negro slaves and their increase  
to wife Neal Roberts and his wife Lucy and her daughter Emma Estor and Mary:  
Archibald. I also give to my beloved wife Nancy Boykin all of my stock of horses cattle sheep and hogs  
all of my crops of brandy corn peas fodder which is all of my house hold and kitchen  
furniture of every description and all of my farming utensils to her and her heirs forever.  
3. I leave to my beloved wife Nancy Boykin during the term of her natural life my great  
hills my two mill caps and worms all my lands and all my Negro slaves not named above  
in the income item of this my last will and testament.

4. At the death of my beloved wife Nancy Boykin I give to the children of my friend  
James B. Urquhart the one half of the above named Negro slaves referred to in the third  
item of this my last will and testament with their increase to them and their heirs forever  
reserving however to my friend James B. Urquhart @ life estate in them the said Negro slaves.

5. At the death of my beloved wife Nancy Boykin I give to the children of my  
friend and relation John Boykin son of Simon Boykin deceased the one half of the above  
named the other half of the said named Negro slaves referred to in the third item of this  
my last will and testament with their increase to them and their heirs forever reserving  
however to my friend John Boykin son of Simon @ life estate in them the said Negro  
slaves.

6. At the death of my beloved wife Nancy Boykin I give my brick hills and
