

sufficiently for one years support for one year: supports both of my wife and other debts and other fixtures for serving fruit which I may have or my plantation & house and to hold the same to him and his heirs forever.

Item 11th It is my will and desire that the balance of my Estate not hereinbefore given away excepting my slaves shall be sold and the money arising from the sale thereof after the payment of my just debts shall be divided together with my other money due my Estate into ten equal parts amongst my children and grand children as follows: say one equal part to Nancy Goode one to Peggy Gregg one to Henshaw Darrow one to Edwin Darrow one to Samuel Darrow one to Darrow one to James Darrow one to my Grand children Children of my daughter Susan Jones to be equally divided between them or their descendants such descendants being my and in the event of one or more of my daughter Susan Jones children dying before arriving to lawfull age or marrying it is my will that the survivor or survivors or their descendants shall have the said property one fourth of one tenth or equal part to be added to my Grand daughter Francis Wardman Darrow daughter of my son Joseph Darrow provided she lives to arrive to lawfull age and marry and leaves one quarter of one tenth thus allotted I desire to remain in the hands of my Executors until they will or will not apply the interest of this legacy that is the income of the legacy to the benefit of my Grand daughter F. W. Darrow before such happens as above named should they deem it necessary to apply the income of the said legacy I will they shall not be held accountable notwithstanding she should die before arriving to lawfull age or marrying or bearing on issue the remaining three fourths of the tenth part to be returned and included in the balance of my Estate for distribution amongst my other legatees the remaining tenth part I will shall be held by my Executors for the benefit of my Grand children Children of my daughter Francis S. Robinson to be paid to each their respective share as they arrive of lawfull age and shall return any of them die before arriving to lawfull age or receiving their respective parts of will and desire that the survivor or survivors of them or their descendants such descendants being the share which their Parent would if living been entitled to to have this said property this one tenth part thus allotted to my daughter Francis S. Robinson & children will be subject to deduction of one hundred and ten pounds two shillings referred to in the last Item.

Item 12th It is my will and desire that my Grand children of Susan Jones shall receive to my Estate for the sum of one hundred and twenty pounds which was for the purchase of a tract of land from Arthur Stevens which land they have sold and not for the benefit of

Item 13th It is my will and desire if my Executors discover there cannot be effected an equal division in the one tenth part of my slaves which may be allotted my daughter Francis S. Robinson's children between the said Grand children I wish my Executors to make sale of the said one tenth and distribute the money arising from the sale among to the said Grand children under the same restrictions as above referred to and it is further my will
