Item 11th It is my will and desire that the balance of my Estate not herebefore
 given away excepting my share shall be sold and the money arising from the sale
 thereof after the payment of my Just debts shall be divided together with my share
 and other moneys due my Estate into two equal parts amongst my children and grand
 children as follows: say one equal part to Nancy Heath one to Peggy Briggs one to
 Humphrey Drury one to Edwin Drury one to Samuel Drury one to John
 Drury one to James Drury one to my Grand children - Children of my daughter Susan
 Jones to be equally divided between them or their descendants such descendants having only
 the share or shares which their said parents or parents would have had if they were living
 and in the want of one or more of my daughter Susan Jones children dying before coming
 to lawful age or marrying It is my will that the survivor or survivors of their descendants
 shall have the said property one fourth of one tenth or equal part to be allotted
 to my Grand daughter Frances Woodman Drury daughter of my son Wright Drury
 provided she lives to come to lawful age and marriage and lives on issue the one
 fourth of one tenth thus allotted I desire to remain in the hands of my Executors
 and should my Grand daughter never arrive to lawful age and marriage and lives on issue
 to live to enjoy this property in that case I will the one fourth of one tenth thus
 allotted to be returned to my other legacies I leave it to the discretion of my Executors
 whether they will or will not apply the interest of this legacy that is the income of
 the legacy to the benefit of my Grand daughter Frances Drury before such happening
 as above named should they deem it necessary to apply the income of the said legacy
 I will they shall not be held accountable notwithstanding she should die before coming
 to lawful age or marrying or marrying on issue the remaining three fourths of the tenth
 part to be returned and included in the balance of my Estate for distribution amongst
 my other legacies the remaining tenth part I will shall be held by my Executors
 for the benefit of my Grand children - Children of my daughter Frances & Robinson to be
 paid to each their respective share as they arrive to lawful age and shall survive
 any of them die before arriving to lawful age or receiving their respective part I will
 and desire that the survivor or survivors of them or their descendants such descendants having
 the share which their Parent would if living have entitled to to have the said property
 this one tenth part thus allotted to my daughter Frances & Robinson children will be
 subject to discount of one hundred and two pounds two shillings referred to in the last
 Item.

Item 12th It is my will and desire that my Grand children of Susan Jones shall
 account to my Estate for the sum of one hundred and twenty pounds which was for the
 purchase of 60 acres of land from Arthur Freeman which land they have sold and used
 the benefit of.

Item 13th It is my will and desire if my Executors discovers there cannot be effected
 an equal division in the one tenth part of my share which may be allotted my daughter
 Frances & Robinson children between the said Grand children I wish my Executors to make
 sale of the said one tenth and distribute the money arising from the sale among the
 said Grand children under the same restrictions as above referred to and it is further my will
