Nov 14 and Lastly I nominate and appoint my two sons Samuel and John Drenway my whole and sole Executors to this my last will and testament revoking all other wills by me made and declaring this to be my last. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 19th day of March in the year of our Lord 1842.

A Court held for the County of Southampton on the 18th day of November 1844
This Last will and testament of Thompson Drenway de^d was proved by the oaths of Wm B Goodwyn & John H Felthought two of the subscribing witnesses thereto and ordered to be Recorded And on the Motion of Samuel & John Drenway the Executors therein named who made oath and together with Wm B Goodwyn & John H Felthought their securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of one hundred thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs to be granted them for obtaining a probate of said will in due form
Dated 18th Dec 1844

In the Name of God Amen I Argil W Bryant of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia do Make and Ordain this my last will and Testament in Manner and form following
that is to say

Will

1st I Give that my Executor herein after named pay all my just debts out of my perishable Estate
2nd I Give to William D Bryant and Bona J Bryant; sons of Davis Bryant; all my Negro Slaves to wit; Willie Margaret Lucy Mary & Margaret's Youngest child; not yet named; the increase of the females to them; & their heirs forever
3rd I Give to Caroline Bryant; daughter of said Davis Bryant; all my interest in the lands of my Father William Bryant; de^d to her and her heirs forever
4th I Give all the balance of my Estate to be equally divided between the said William D Bryant; Bona J Bryant; and Caroline Bryant; to them & their heirs forever
And Lastly I hereby nominate and appoint Davis Bryant; my Brother Executor of this my last will and Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 18th day of September in the year of our Lord 1844.
