It appears that the Trustee paid R. W. Smith one of the childrens of Polly Smith on the 1 day of February 1844 the sum of £105 37½ as a part of the taxes for 1843. bearing as the receipt says £35 10 due all arrears which up Charles Smith who was present with C. A. Pelway, Trust of Henry Pelway before the Court stated that son R. W. Smith was not authorized to receive any part of this money and that he was not accounted with his mother or any of the parties for one cent of it and that therefore he could not admit his receipt as so much received and claims the whole and due I believe they finally agreed to refer the matter to disinterested persons of the receipt should be allowed it should bear interest from its date & be deducted from the above balance & come for £2 charged to the latter
