The Commissioner begs leave to state that the Commissioners are allowed the admⁿ on receipts after the year 1833 as he rendered no account subsequent to that year within the time prescribed by law it was objected before the Com^{rs} that the item of \$148 25 for account retained by the admⁿ in the year 1832 ought not to be allowed on the ground of want of sufficient evidence to prove their justness. The Commissioner did not think it proper to require proof of their justness under the exceptions filed because the item was included in an account rendered by the admⁿ reported and confirmed many years ago without exceptions. If that item had been excepted to when the account was first reported at the proper time it might have been in the power of the admⁿ to have adduced the necessary evidence since that time the admⁿ has died and there is no possibility of producing the evidence. It seems to the Com^{rs} therefore that the item in question could not be inquired into by them under the exceptions recently filed and that the only remedy is by bill to discharge and satisfy &c.
