At a Court held for the County of Southampton on the 21st day of April 1843
This Last Will and Testament of Rebecca Holloman did was proved by the oaths of Mills & Bray & Kearse & Johnson two of the subscribing witnesses and ordered to be Recorded and there being no other appearance of Josiah Manry who made oath and together with J. H. Tinsley & R. Edwards his securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the sum of five hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for
