make and ordain this to be my last will and testament in manner and form as follows
I wish
Sarah Powell I send unto Tinsell S. Powell the tract of land whereon I have been
dwelling his natural life and if he should die without lawful issue of his body I
will
give the same unto John S. Powell and his heirs forever but if the said Tinsell S.
Powell should arrive at lawful age and marry and have children then and in that
case the land is to be a gift to Tinsell S. Powell and his heirs forever the said
tract of land contains by old survey two hundred and thirty five acres more or less.
Item 2^d I give unto Tinsell S. Powell one bed and furniture and one fine chest
to him and his heirs forever.

Item 3^d I give unto John S. Powell one bed and furniture and one fine chest to him
and his heirs forever.

There 4th My will and desire is at my death that all my household and
kitchen furniture and all my stock of hogs shall be sold and equally divided
between my several children In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and affixed my seal this eighteenth day of April in the year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred and forty five
