and State of Virginia being in law health but of sound mind and memory do
make and ordain this to be my last will and testament in manner and form as follows

Powell to wife

I leave the first I lend unto Titelton S Powell the tract of land wherow I have lies
during his natural life and if he shoulde die without lawful issue of his body I
give the same unto John S Powell and his heirs forever but if the said Titelton S.
Powell shoulde arrive at lawful age and marry and have children then and in that
case the land is to be a gift to Titelton S Powell and his heirs forever the said
tract of land contains by old survey two hundred and thirty five acres more or less
Item 2^d I give unto Titelton S Powell one bed and furniture and one pair of chay
to him and his heirs forever

Item 3 I give unto John S Powell one bed and furniture and one pair of chay to him
and his heirs forever

Item 4^m My will and desire is at my death that all my household and
kitchen furniture and all my stock of hogs cattle &c be sold and equally divided
between my several children In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and affixed my seal this eighteenth day of April in the year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred and forty five
