Now the Name of God Amen I Elizabeth Harris of the County of Southampton
being weak of body but of a sound mind and disposing Memory do hereby and
advise this my last will and testament hereby revoking all former wills or testaments
heretofore made by me I Give to my daughter Sally Powell the following property to wit
all my house hold and kitchen furniture stock of all descriptions and farming
tools and the following Negroes: Peter Averying young and little Peter and their
increase I also leave to my daughter Sally Powell and Negro Man Moses during
her life and at her death to go to my Grand son School Thomas Powell to him and
his heirs forever I also leave to my daughter Sally Powell the tract of land known as
the Francis tract and at her death it is my will and desire that it should go to
School Thomas Powell to him and his heirs forever and should the said School Thomas Powell
die before arriving to twenty one years old or without then that it is my will and
desire that the land should go to School Thomas Powell to him and his heirs forever
Second I Give to my Grand son Harris Powell the tract of land on which he
now lives with all the improvements and all the property that I have given him
before which he now has in his possession I also leave him the following Negroes
Frank Charles Droussilla and Philip with their increase and at his death it is
my will and desire that they should be equally divided between his then living
children and their heirs forever.

Third I Give to my Grand son School Thomas Powell the following Negroes to wit
Frisia Chack Harward Austin Oscar Ephraim and Jimmy with their increase and
bed and furniture and New chest one bay colt one cow and calf and the pair of
hogs which he now owns with all of their increase to him and his heirs
forever.

Fourth I Give to my Grand daughter Elizabeth Moore the following property to
wit Living Cattle Allen and Melly and their increase and bed and furniture
and trunk one cow and calf during her life and should the said Elizabeth Moore
die without leaving a lawful heir it is my will and desire that the property shall
be equally divided among my then living Grand children and their heirs forever.

Fifth I Give to my Grand son William T. Powell the following property to wit One
Pleasant and their increase and at the death of Sally Powell the tract of land known
as the Francis tract to him and his heirs forever and should the said William T.
Powell die before arriving to twenty one years or without a lawful heir then
it is my will and desire that the above named property should go to School
