1<sup>st</sup> I desire that all my perishable estate be sold immediately after my decease and the monies arising from such sale first to pay all of my Just debts and if my perishable estate should prove insufficient to pay my just debts my desire is that my negro woman Aggy and child John be sold by my Executor hereafter named and the remaining part of my debts be paid out of the proceeds of such sale and the balance of any to be equally divided between my sister Martha M. Epps and my niece Martha W. Smith which I give to them and their heirs forever

2<sup>nd</sup> I Give to my sister Martha M. Epps all my farther Joel McSmore did, which I Give to her and her heirs forever.

3<sup>rd</sup> I Give to my niece Martha W. Smith my Gold watch which I Give to her and her heirs forever

4<sup>th</sup> I do constitute and appoint my trusty friend William A. Leno Executor to this my last will and testament With witnesses whose names I have hereunto set by hand and affixed
