make my last will and testament in manner and form following

1st My Will and desire is that all my just debts be paid out of my estate.
2^d I give to my daughter Sally Wrights three children the sum of fifty
dollars to be equally divided

3^d I give unto my wife Martha the following property to wit three beds spanning
three tables one china press two chest one round harpised box chairs the cooking
of the house also ten barrels corn five hundred pounds of pork one thousand
pounds of fodder one milk cow one sow pigs (or one sow with pig) two iron pots
1 one spider one tow kettle & ten dollars in cash To have the whole unless some
night 4th I Give unto my son John Booths lawful children Two that he has
now or may hereafter have the balance of my estate that I am now in possession
of or may hereafter have

5th I also wish and desire that my son John Booths shall be my legal
representative of my estate

Lastly I hereby constitute and ordain this to be my last will and testament and
do hereby revoke and annul all other wills heretofore made by me this Testimony
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 27th day of Jan^y 1845
