of all my estate to be equally divided unto William V. Corlett and Joseph H. Johnson unto
them and their heirs forever

That I do nominate constitute and appoint my friend Joseph H. Johnson as Executor to this
my last will and testament witness my hand and seal this 15th day of September 1845
