 and testament in manner and form following to wit:  
 I do hereby certify that I am the said Joseph Turner of Southampton County

My will and desire is that all my just debts and expenses be paid  
 I leave unto my beloved wife Polly Turner all the rest of my estate both real and  
 personal so long as she lives my widow but if she should marry again my will is that one  
 half of all my estate be sold and the money arising from said sale to be equally divided between  
 William V Corbit and Joseph H. Johnson and at the death of my wife I leave the balance  
 of all my estate to be equally divided unto William V Corbit and Joseph H. Johnson unto  
 them and their heirs forever

I do hereby certify and appoint my friend Joseph H. Johnson as Executor to this  
 my last will and testament Witness my hand and seal this 1st day of September 1845

 March 1846. This Last Will and Testament of Joseph Turner dec was proved by the oaths of  
 Thomas S. White and Nathan Suler the subscribing witnesses thereto and ordered to be Recorded  
 And on the Motion of J. H. Johnson the Executor thereof named who made oath and together  
 with Nathan Suler and William V Corbit his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond on  
 the penalty of five hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs and is granted him for claiming  
 a probate of said will in due form
