

Sufficient to pay all my just debts together with the expenses of interment, including all sums due after which I Give to my wife one third of the remainder of my real and personal estate during her natural life and as much of my estate as she my said wife shall like to foregoe to my inheritance with her I Give to her my said wife & her heirs forever
 3th I Give to my Daughter Deborah Worrell one dollar to have her heirs & assigns forever
 4th I Give to my Daughter Worrell one dollar to have my said daughter her heirs forever
 5th I Give to my son Miles Worrell one dollar to have my said son his heirs forever
 6th I Give to my son Nathan Worrell one dollar to have my said son his heirs forever
 7th The Balance of my estate both real and personal I Give to my two youngest children that is to say the two by my last marriage namely Esther Worrell and Elizabeth Worrell the same to be equally divided between them two children or as they live so as each will be due to them and each of them my said two sons & their heirs and assigns forever
 Lastly I do hereby nominate & appoint my friend Jacob Barnes the executor of this my last will and I do hereby certify I have herewith set my hand and seal the 28th day of April 1839

Worrell and Augustine Pope his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of two hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted them for Hanning a probat of said will in due form
