Southampton and State of Virginia being of sound and perfect Mind and
Memory blessed be God do this 1st October in the year of our Lord God
thousand eight hundred & forty six make and publish this my Last
Will and Testament in manner following (Viz)

Item 1st I Give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Lucy Gray Ored
double Ligg. One hundred choice of my stock fifty barrels corn One
thousand pounds Potatoes all the property which I obtained by her from
my intermarriage I also have unto my said wife Lucy Ored Negro woman
Pharo during her natural life.

Item 2nd I Give and bequeath unto my nephew Henry W. Gray the
following Negroes namely Cor. Lills Sam. Cato Edmund Ruler Henriable
Lucy Selby Chancy Isaac Mariah George a Wherry, Beahel, Amador
and Fitch any three and their increase to him and his heirs forever
I also Give unto my said nephew Henry W. Gray my plantation known as
the White plantation which I purchased of Smith and Dorrell to him and
his heirs forever

Item 3rd I Give and bequeath unto my nephew Benjamin D. Dodge the
following Negroes namely Amy, Mary, Frank, Harry and Aaron and
all the balance of my estate not given away after the payment of my
Just debts to him and his heirs forever It is my will and desire that
the said Benjamin Dodge shall take care of and support gently his
