At a Court held for the County of Southampton on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of February  
1847. This last Will and Testament, of Nancy Newcomb <sup>and</sup> <sup>Intervener</sup>, was presented by  
the Oaths of Jacob Warner and C. S. Griffin <sup>as of the Writings</sup> to come  
before to be Recorded and on the Motion of Same Griffin the Executor  
of said Nancy who made back and together with Jacob Warner <sup>William Nick</sup>  
his securities entered into and acknowledged at home in the presence of two  
hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs certificated is granted him for  
obtaining a probat of said Will in due form.

I Jason Gardner of the county of Southampton and state of Virginia do  
hereby make my last Will and Testament in manner and form following:

1<sup>st</sup> After paying all my just debts and funeral expenses I leave my  
dwelling house & kitchen & garden to my Daughter Ann Gardner to have full use  
of during her Natural or single life or until such time as the death of my son  
Sam'l R. Gardner which may happen first and after the death of said Sam'l  
R. Gardner his wife shall have full proportion of this dwelling house and kitchen  
and allow my daughter Ann Gardner to live with him during her single life  
I give her all my kitchen furniture the first choice of my feather beds  
and furniture one Black Cow and calf down flag bottom chairs. My bedding  
less the use of my dairy 300 lbs pork or Bacon and 5 barrels of corn to  
her and her heirs forever.

2<sup>d</sup> I give to my son Sam'l R. Gardner wherent I now live containing  
98 acres more or less to him and his heirs forever

3<sup>r</sup> I give to my daughter Eliza Gardner my feather bed & furniture to  
her and her heirs forever

4<sup>th</sup> I give to my Grand daughter Caroline Susan Daugtry my feather  
bed and furniture to her and her heirs forever

5<sup>th</sup> I leave my tract of Land known by the name of piney woods  
containing 50 acres more or less to be sold with all the residue of my estate  
not having given way or mentioned above all my just debts and  
funeral expenses paid and the residue of the money equally divided  
between my children Eliza Gardner Everett Gardner Sam'l R. Gardner and  
Gardner and my Grand daughter Caroline Susan Daugtry to whom  
and their heirs forever.

Now Lastly I do hereby constitute my son Everett Gardner & Jas. R.  
Gardner Executors of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all  
other or former Wills or testaments by me herefore made. In witness  
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the 1<sup>st</sup> day  
of December 1846
