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Kello by her certificate which was proved in court refused to take upon herself the burden of the execution of said Will. And on the Motion of Arthur A. Drury who made oath and together with William R. Stephenson and Samuel Kello his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of two thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration with the Will annexed of the said Richard Kello. say in due form
