Thirdly I give to my daughter Martha Pope and my son Eliza Pope one half of the balance of my estate to be equally divided between them Fourthly I give the balance of my estate to the following Thomas Pope John Edgington Pope Agilula Chomate Pope Lucy Ann Pope and Mary Sam Pope and to my daughter Rachel Childs four children (viz) Pick Buffin Chitney Martha Ann Chitney Catharina Thomas Chitney and the fourth an infant child not named to be equally divided among the last three named children Lastly I desire and appoint my son Eliza Pope to execute this my last Will and Testament I also desire that my Executor shall not receive out of my Daughter Martha Pope any bond for my keeping her Negroes viz Chancy Blak and boy Tom.
