I James Moore of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia being of
sound mind and body but being about to depart for the Mexican War as a member of
the Volunteer Regiment of Virginia do hereby make my last Will and Testament in
Manner form following: After my death I desire that all my Just debts shall be paid
if any I may owe and that my Executor hereinafter named shall reduce the whole
of my estate into possession and continue to hold the same until the expiration of
twenty years from the date of this Will: that is until the 8th day of January in
the year 1867: And as my wife Mary and my daughter Rebecca Moore have in
my opinion been abridely sufficiently provided for by me and as I do not wish
my estate to rest in my daughter before the 8th day of January 1867 as well as
by reason of the friendships and affections which I entertain for my Executor hereinafter
named: I desire that he shall not pay any interest on the moneys which shall
come to his hands as Executor as aforesaid: but that he shall have the full use of the
same without charge until the 8th day of January 1867: If my said daughter shall
be alive on the said 8th day of January 1867 then I will, and bequeath the whole
of my estate to her: but if she shall die before that time then I will, and bequeath
the whole of my said estate to Harrison D. Moore: And I do hereby constitute
and appoint Harrison D. Moore Executor to this my last Will and Testament: Now
Witness my hand and seal the 8th day of January in the year of our Lord 1847
