my last Will and Testament in manner and form following (to wit)
Item 1st I Give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Nancy Waller one half and furniture
first choice two bushels such as she may make choice of one cow and pig one cow and calf but
bushels can give hundred pounds pork to her and her heirs forever
Item 2nd I Give unto my beloved wife Nancy Waller one third part of the remainder
of my property after the payment of all my just debts as long as she may live and
as her death the said property to be equally divided between my two sons Benjamin C
and Ben C Waller to share and their heirs forever
Item 3rd I Give and bequeath unto my son Benjamin C Waller one third
