I General Davis of the County of Southampton State of N.Y. do make this my Last Will and Testament in manner and form as follows (18)

First: I give unto my son Silas Davis my tract of Land wherein he now lives it being the same tract that I bought of my brother William Davis to him and his heirs forever. I leave unto my three daughters Amanda, Emma & Oliver Davis my tract of land wherein I have her during her single life, at their intermarriage or death, I leave it to my son Silas Davis choice to pay to my estate the sum of two hundred dollars and take the said Land but provided he should not chose to take the Land at the above terms then she said Emma to be sold and the money arising therefrom to be equally divided between my children Matilda Hobson, Mary Williams, Martha Williams, Amanda Davis, Engel Davis, Oliver Davis & Eliza Davis & George Davis but provided my son Silas should chose to take the Land and pay two hundred Dollars then that amount to be equally divided in the same manner as I have above directed provided he should not choose to take the Land.

Second: I give unto my daughter Amanda Davis my feather bed and furniture together with all the other bed furniture that she has made and calls her own.

Third: I give unto my daughter Oliver Davis my feather bed and furniture together with all the other bed furniture that she has made and calls her own.

Fifth: All my property of every kind whatever set being disposed of to be sold out of which pay my just debts and the surplus if any to be equally divided between my children named in the second section of this will.

I do hereby constitute and appoint my son Eliza Davis and Elizah Hobson Curator to this my Last Will & Testament Rousing all who wills herefore by me sealed in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my
