Virginia being in sound and perfect mind and disposing memory do make and declare  
this to be my last will and testament in the manner and form as followeth to  
wit<sup>th</sup> I leave to William Barrett son of John Barrett all my wearing  
clothes and best clothes except first choice of my blankets  
I leave to John Henderson one first choice of my spotted blankets  
the balance of my property except my Virginia say furniture beds chest trunks  
&c desired to be sold and the proceeds to go to pay my debts as far as it will go  
I leave 3<sup>d</sup> I wish for my Virginia to be hired out until they have paid for enough to  
pay all my debts and expenses and about I leave that they will be emancipated  
and go free And Lastly I do nominate and appoint my friend Edmund  
Bryan Executor to this my last will and testament according to all other  
will or wills herebefore lawfully made by me. In witness whereunto I have  
this 10<sup>th</sup> day of December eighteenth hundred and forty four set my hand  
and affix my seal in presence of  
James Luby
