In the Name of God Amen. I Thomas Partidge of the County of Southampton and State of Va do make and publish this my last Will and Testament in manner and form as follows

I Give to my beloved wife two best choice beds and good and sufficient clothing to her and her heirs forever I also Give her my single barrel Gun "I" and I Give my wife during her life the use of my Negro Man Peter Adamant Raising and Soil Horrid.

It is my Will and desire that my Executor herein named do sell the plantation whereon I now live and with the proceeds of such sale buy some place with the consent of my wife. which place to purchase I leave my wife during her life I also Give my wife the Interest on all moneys that may arise from the sale of my debt and funeral expences. "3." All the property herein bequeathed my wife at her death I Give to my daughter Mary Francis to her and her heirs forever provided she live to the age of twenty and at her death a lawful heir of her body.

In the event of my daughters death before arriving to the age of twenty and without her I Give all the property herein named to the children of my wife if she has any and if she has no child then I Give the whole of the above property to James & Peter to him and his heirs forever. WITNESSEY I do hereby certify and appoint my friend James & Peter Executor of this my last Will and Testament. At a Court held for the County of Southampton on the 15th day of January 1849 This Last Will and Testament of Thomas Partidge was proved by the Oaths of R. F. Dasher James R. M. Plumer and William D. Morris the subscribing witnesses thereto and ordered to be Recorded. And at the Motion of James & Peter the Executor therein named who made oath and together with James D. Drury the R. Dasher and Soil Prince his witnesses entered into and acknowledged at Bond in the penalty of three thousand dollars conditional as the last direct Certificate is granted here for obtaining a probate of said Will in due form

In the Name of God Amen. I John Drury of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia do hereby make and publish this to be my last Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say

I Give unto my daughter Mary Jane Drury and her heirs Adamant named O'Pier and her children Edward & Richard provided she said Adamant be alive and consented to be named and the future interest but should the said Adamant not be alive and consented to be named then it is my Will and desire that she shall have choice of my female Negroes also one thousand dollars and an equal portion of my white estate
