Jan 3 By cash Received from sundries on bonds:
October 20th 1848 The Commissioner says he has to state specially that he has allowed to commissions the said estate not having been settled on two years also that he has charged the Executor with the interest; Sally Wrenn the testator having willed that Barham Wrenn the Executor should have all the money and bonds belonging to her estate without paying any interest he keeping said money until the legacies named in the Will came of age or married then to pay over to such one his portion of the money and so to the others that out of the legacies has received her distributable share and that Barham Wrenn administrator is now holding the other share until the remaining legacies come of age or marry all of which Respectfully submitted
