That 1st I Give and bequeath to my beloved wife during her lifetime my mansion house
together with all the Land lying west of the Land running from Peter Edwards land to Richd
Peters land including the Peter tract of Land at her death I Give the same to my son
William P. Francis in fee simple forever the remainder of my Land I wish divided between
my other three sons Nathaniel, J. John D. and Andrew J. Francis to be surveyed by Thomas
B. Wrenell and divided according to valuation by Peter Edwards. Mark J. Peter & R. Thomas
and Nathl. Simmons.

That 2nd I direct that my wife shall select her share of my negro property of such
as she may prefer so that she do not take more than one third in value the remain
my two thirds to be equally divided between all my children.

That 3rd I Give to my wife my hussy & harness one horse cart one ox cart and
