

All my tract of Land whereon I had a right containing most hundred acres more or less the same subject to the above clause of about twenty five acres;
 4th After my decease I desire that my brother Jacob Barnes shall take possession of my whole tract of Land except the house and barns and pay to my said wife Susan annually and short part of the produce raised on my said plantation or use of Land for the term of her Natural life;

5th I Give to my said wife Susan one further bed & furniture and spinning wheel & cards and some harness and cows calf (first choice) and sow & pig (first choice) two ewes & lambs (first choice) two Hares two (first choice) two chicks two first choice, six first choice sitting chairs and my crockery utensils knives & forks and various Ware tubs pails and hogens two barrels bushels all my plantation and farming tools &c to her and her heirs forever;

6th I Give Susan buffer she take her own use;

7th All the balance of my Estate not otherwise disposed of a love I Give to the said James Barnes M Barnes and his brother Jacob Barnes Benjamin & Pope and Harrison P Pope to be equally divided between them;

8th And Lastly I hereby nominate and appoint my friend Thos B Dorrill Executor of this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all other former Wills or Testaments by me heretofore made: In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 14th day of March in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and forty four
