In the Name of God Amen. I Thomas Vaughan being of sound
 body but of sound and disposing mind do now declare this to be my last
 Will and Testament as follows to wit: after the payment of all my just
 debts I wish my wife to retain all of the property in her possession during
 her widowhood. Should she marry again the property must be divided and she
 must take what the Law allows her, during the time the property is held in the
 possession of my wife, I do not wish my children charged any thing for debts
 as soon as any of my children marry or arrive respectively to the age of twenty
 and I wish each of them to have a Negro Girl: To my Daughter Virginia
 give a Girl by the Name of Betty: To Cecil my oldest son a Girl by the
 Name of Agnes Francis; my next oldest son, I wish him to have a Girl
 by the Name of Kate; To my son Richard Sumner I give a Negro Girl
 by the Name of Amanda; Should either of the Negroes die as named above
 their place I wish supplied by another to be given in place of such an
 one dying: Should my wife have a posthumous child I wish that child
 to share as my other children and also to take a Negro I wish my wife
 Mariak O Vaughan and Sumner & Cobb to administer upon and take charge
 of my estate. In Witness of above I hereunto affix my hand and seal
 this 24th of July 1847

At a Court held for the County of Southampton on the 20th day of August 1847.
 This Last Will and Testament of Thomas Vaughan was proved by the Oaths of
 M. W. Vaughan, Henry Fowler and W. S. Maphurbury the subscribing Witnesses
 thereto and ordered to be recorded: Mariak O Vaughan, the Executrix named
 in said Will appeared in Court and refused to take upon themselves the burden of
 the Execution of said Will; Whereupon on the Motion of the said Mariak
 O Vaughan who makes oath and together with Sumner & Cobb Sumner & Cobb
 and Daniel W Cobb her securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in
 the penalty of eight thousand dollars conditioned on the Law doth; Certificate
 is granted him for obtaining letters of administration with the Will annexed
 aforesaid of the said Thomas Vaughan Esq in due form

In the Name of God Amen. I Zachary Story of the County of
 Southampton and State of Virginia do hereby make and publish this my last
 Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say:
 1st after my decease I desire that my Executors herein after named shall
 sell all such part of my personal Estate, as is not herein otherwise disposed
 of, and pay all my just debts and funeral expenses: I also desire that my
 said Executors shall sell my Negro man Jim privately to a good Master
 to any person said Jim may choose to buy him: provided they can sell
 at a fair price: but in case they cannot, I desire that they shall hire him
