

This Last Will and Testament of Zachus Story deed was proved by the oath of
 Thos. B. Worrell and John O. Bealer two of the subscribing witnesses thereof
 or decessed to be recorded; Benjamin Story one of the Executors named and
 will bring deed, with Thomas B. Worrell the other Executors named in said
 will approved in court and refused to take upon himself the burden of said
 the execution of said will; whereupon on the Motion of said Thomas
 B. Worrell and John O. Bealer who were oath and together with Robert S.
 Baime and Ben. O. Pope their securities entered into and acknowledged at least
 in the penalty of Ten thousand dollars conditional as the Law directs: and
 is granted them for obtaining letters of administration on the Estate of the said
 Zachus Story dead with his will aforesaid approved in court
 J. R. C. Edwards, C. C.

Memorandum:

First: I Give my body to the clerk and my spirit to
 my God who give it, and as to such worldly Estate as it hath pleased God to
 entrust me with I dispose of the same as follows. After settling my estate,
 Item: I leave to my beloved wife during her life my Negro man Simon
 - his Woman Cherry, Cady and three youngest children: also the choice of my
 horses and Ligs. (one each) two beds, one table and chest & trunk, the loom & one
 spinning wheel and such of my cooking utensils as he may select: also the
 buffet & contents and dog chairs with knives and forks and silverware: also three
 cows & calves, half dog head sheep, two sows & pigs and provision enough for one
 years support for herself and Stock family &c also all that portion of my home
 tract of Land lying on the North side of a certain Mulberry tree standing near
 the house in which Everett Fowler now lives, said line to run parallel to that
 portion of the present crop fence near said tree, as it runs in front of said
 house to the bar:

Item: 2nd I Give to my son Richard Davis the tract of Land above named
 and bound to his mother with the appertinances to him and his heirs forever;
 3rd I Give to the children of my daughter Margaret O. Carrow the tract
 of Land on which they now live called the Rainbow Brilt tract, the West tract
 and that part of the paper Brilt tract lying South of the path of the which
 connects the two first named Tracts;

4th I Give to my Daughter Susan O. Bryant the balance of the paper
 Brilt tract lying North of the path aforesaid which runs running West from
 Perry Carrow's also all the William O. Brilt tract whereon Mrs. Murches
 now lives with its appertinances to her and her heirs forever;

Item 5th I Give to my Daughter Catharine O. Bryant my Belliant
 tract and Carter tract of Land together with that part of my home tract
 not before given away lying nearly South West of a line mentioned in
 Item 2nd running straight by a certain Mulberry tree and parallel
 a part of the present crop fence near it as before described

6th I Give to my daughter Caroline W. Sharp all my four North tract
 of Land together with the adjoining portion of the William O. Brilt tract
 lying North of a line to commence in the Silas Branch and John Rogers
 line thence down the various corners of said Silas Branch and John Rogers
 first one of apple trees nearest the house in the young orchard: thence
