

said Row of apple trees and a line in the same direction, through the low ground to the Meherrin River or perhaps to what was Rockhills line to her and her heirs forever she paying to my son John Wesley the sum of one hundred Dollars  
7<sup>th</sup> I Give to my son Joseph Bryan all the balance of the Oak Hill tract of Land not heron before given away and lying about south of the before named line to commence where the Silas Branch intersects with John Harde's line thence down the various courses of said branch to establish the first row of apple trees nearest the dwelling house in the young orchard thence along said Row of trees and its direction through the low ground to the out line of Meherrin river or Oak Rockhills line with its appurtenances as to him and his heirs forever.

8<sup>th</sup> I Give to my son William D Bryan the Midget tract of Land on which he now lives with its appurtenances to him and his heirs forever he receiving from his Brother Bryan J Bryan one hundred Dollars.

9<sup>th</sup> Although I have before devised to my son Bryan J Bryan the tract of Land on which he now lives yet in order to equalize the different shares it is my desire that he pay to his father William D Bryan the sum of one hundred Dollars.

10<sup>th</sup> I Give to my son John Wesley Bryan all that portion of my Matt Williams tract of Land lying west of a line to be made commencing at Owens old Mill seat thence along a straight line to Emanuel Hurst spring in or near the head of a small bottom or branch thence along the said branch to what was Albens Mill pond together with the appurtenances to him and his heirs forever he receiving from Susan C. (Caroline W Sharp) the sum of one hundred Dollars; 11<sup>th</sup> I Give to the children of my daughter Sarah Jane Bryan all the balance of my Matt Williams tract of Land which may hereafter of the before mentioned line to be made commencing at Owens old Mill seat thence straight to Emanuel Hurst spring thence along its branch to Albens Mill pond to them and their heirs forever.

12<sup>th</sup> After settling my Estate it is my desire that the balance remaining of my Negroes and Chattel estate be equally divided between all my children to wit; Susan C. Catharine C. W. D. Bryan, J. Joseph S. Richard S. John Wesley Bryan, J. Margaret D. Conant, Caroline W Sharp, & Sarah J. Barritt, share alike to them and their heirs forever;

13<sup>th</sup> I hereby nominate and appoint my two sons William D. Bryan & J. Bryan my Executors to this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all other Wills heretofore by me made: In Witness whereof I Davis Bryan the Testator have to this my last Will and Testament written one one sheet of paper set my hand and seal this 14<sup>th</sup> day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty nine
