in full simple after paying my just debts and funeral expenses my will and
desire is that my wife to be my Executor to this my last Will and Testament:

twenty seventh in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty one

being duly sworn deposes and swears that he is well acquainted with the
hand writing of the said Benjamin Saml and verily believes that the signature
to the said Will purporting to be his is genuine: Whereupon it is ordered
that the said writing be recorded as and for the Last Will and Testa-
ment of the said James S. Holt: And Nancy Holt the Executrix therein
named refused to take upon herself the burden of the Execution of said Will
on motion of Thomas Kitchy who made oath and testified with Holt &
Kitchy his pecuniary interest in it and acknowledged as such in the presence
of five hundred Dollars conditioned as the Law directs. Confirmed
