Lastly: I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my son Johnam Corbick & my friend Brigg Triffin as Executors to this my last Will and Testament, revoking all others heretofore by me made:

Second: I Give to my wife Martha S. Simmons the sum of seven hundred and fifty dollars provided she relinquish her right to my estate of her interest in the Land which formerly belonged to her Father:

Third: I wish the balance of my estate to be equally divided between my wife Martha S. Simmons and my children:

Lastly: I nominate my Father Nat Simmons and my friend Mark S. Parker Executors to this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all former Wills heretofore made by me: In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twentieth day of October right hand hundred and forty nine:
