

At a Court held for the County of Southampton on the 11th day of December 1849. This Inventory and Appraisement of the Estate of S^r Bury Bryant dec'd was returned and ordered to be Recorded

In the Name of God Amen: I Kinchan Jeths of Southampton County, and State of Virginia, being weak in body, but perfect in mind, do hereby make this my last Will and Testament, in manner and form following, that is to say: 1st I desire that my Negroes George, Ezehial, and John may be hired out until all of my just debts are paid; 2nd after which I give my boy George to my son Joseph A. Jeths to him, and his heirs forever; 3rd I give my boy Ezehial to my son Nathaniel J. Jeths to him and his heirs forever; 4th I give my boy John to my Daughter Petramella J. Jeths to her and her heirs forever; 5th I lend to my wife Nancy Jeths my Land with all kinds of timber & Charcut also my Stock of all kinds, horses, cattle, hogs, sheep, &c. during her Natural life, and at her death for the said property to be sold and from the Money arising therefrom 6th I give to my Daughter Mary Williams formerly Mary Jeths ^{Eighty Dollars} to her and her heirs forever; 7th The balance of my estate, I wish to be equally divided between my Daughter Lucy A. Jeths and my two sons James A. and William R. Jeths, to them and their heirs forever. AND Lastly: I do hereby constitute and appoint my wife Nancy Jeths Executrix of this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all other or former Wills or Testaments by me heretofore made: (write out any responsibility to County) I W Kinchan Jeths of which I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this twenty seventh day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty nine

At a Court held for the County of Southampton on the 2nd day of January 1850. This Last Will and Testament of Kinchan Jeths dec'd was proved by the Oaths of Wm B.R. Edwards and Josiah Manry two of the subscribing Witnesses sworn and admitted to Record: And on the Motion of Nancy Jeths the Executrix thereof named who made Oath and gave acknowledgment a bond in the penalty of Six thousand Dollars conditioned as the Law directs. Certificate is granted her for obtaining a probate of said Will in due form: (The Will directing that no security should be required of the Executrix and the Court requiring none)
