 constituted this my last will and Testament;

1st I direct that all my just debts and burial expences be paid out of my
 Estate

2nd I give and bequeath to my son George Bryant all my land together
 with one handy skill, and more which is now on said lands the present
 and still, I give unto him and his heirs forever;

3rd I give my son George Bryant five Dollars to be paid to him by my
 Executor out of my estate;

4th I give my Daughter Maria Bryant five Dollars to be paid unto her
 by my Executor out of my estate;

5th I give Maria Atkinson wife of Richard Atkinson my large
 silver ring the one which it contains;

6th I give Nancy Gray one large pine chest with all the contents

7th I give; Martha Gray Daughter of James Gray two hand boxes with
 their contents;

8th I give to my son John Bryant the balance of all my estate which
 has not been disposed of both real and personal whatsoever to him
 his heirs forever;

Lastly; I direct that my son John Bryant be my Executor to the
 my last will and Testament; Given under my hand this 18th day
 May 1847.
