Gardner, the sum of Five Dollars, also to pay my son Edwin's
children the sum of One Dollar, to be divided equally amongst all
his said children, also to pay unto my daughter Elizabeth B.
Wellons the sum of One Dollar, also to pay unto my daughter
Susanna Kitchen the sum of Twenty five Dollars, also to pay Virginia
A. Johnson the sum of one Dollar, and if my son Arrington
Gardner do well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the
above named persons the said sums specified as above, then my
Lands to be his and his heirs forever. I do hereby constitute and
appoint my son Arrington Gardner my Executor to this my last
will and testament.
