J. S. Gwaltney In the name of God Amen: I, John S. Gwaltney of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, being in perfect mind & memory, do ordain this my last will and testament, and do dispose of my property in the following manner, To wit:
 1st I leave to my beloved wife Nancy B. Gwaltney the plantation whereon I now live with the furniture of my property, except a negro woman Parthena & children during her life, and after her death it is my wish and desire for my property to be divided in the following manner -
 2^d - I give unto my Daughter Sarah H. Holmes, one feather bed & furniture one Brazer, 6 silver Table spoons, and a negro woman Parthena & her increase, to her and her heirs forever -
 3^d - I give unto my Daughter Susannah McSope one feather bed & furniture one bedat, 6 Caspoons (silver) and one negro boy Willis to her & her heirs forever -
 4. I give unto my son Joseph S. Belpwallow my curtain bedstead, bed & furniture, and the tract of land whereon I now live, to him and his heirs forever -
 5th The remainder of my estate, sold and equally divided between Sarah H. Holmes and Susannah McSope
 6th - I nominate my friends Saml H. Holmes and Robert B. Soper, Executors to this my last will and Testament and all other of this kind is void. Given under my hand and seal this 22nd day of September 1847.
