 The Deponent having been duly sworn, says that Martha Felt has lived with her and in her vicinity until the month of February the present year that Capt. Butts paid the sum of \$5.00 to William Felt for Martha Felt in the year 1842 that in the year 1845, he also furnished her, shoes, dresses &c, that he sent Moses Chappell for services in 1846, that he furnished 1 p. shoes for her servant James 846, and that Martha Felt received some articles sent by Capt. Butts from Dorset and Ellington sometime ago the year not recollects. The Deponent also says that he said Martha Felt had three negro girls the Bot. Freeman that June died in 1849 in the spring. the first names negro is and has been very infirm for twelve months and further the deponent cannot not
