in State of Virginia, do make this my last will and testament as follows
Item the 1st I gave unto my beloved brother Esprit Carson one bed
sheet against him of sixteen dollars and fifty cents dated October 9th 1849.
Also one cow and pigling and three shoats. Also half my corn.
Item 2nd I gave unto Panny Darden my feather bed, one wooden hand
and ears, and looking glass, one candle stand and four shoats and
also the other half of my corn and all my goods to her and her
 heirs forever.

My will and desire is that all the balance of my property be equally
divided between Esprit Carson and Panny Darden after paying my
just debts. I gave unto them these things after my death.
I also leave my beloved brother Esprit Carson into Esprit
I the said Ann Carson do acknowledge this to be my last will and
testament - In witness whereof, I set my hand and seal this
1st day of October in the year of our Lord 1849.
