

The estate of Edwin Richards dec^d

In account with Robert Richards his administrator

The Commissioner has leave to report to the Court that Robert Richards on the 2^d of September 1850, laid his account as administrator of Edwin Richards dec^d before him for an additional settlement. On the last account there was a balance due the estate of \$210⁰⁰ &c etc with interest thereon from the 3rd of December 1840, until paid, subsequent to that settlement Robert Richards paid to Thomas Pettee the sum of \$342.20 &c to which was not included in that account but the administrator in his settlement with the distributees of Edwin Richards retained that amount. The Commissioner reports further that Robert Richards as administrator of Edwin Richards paid on the 15th of July 1839, to James Wilson the sum of \$348.45 &c to which he does not credit with in the last settlement of his administration. The administrator informs the commissioner that he has paid out all the balance found due by the account of December 1840, so the estate now stands indebted to the administrator in the sum of \$548.45 &c with interest thereon from the 15th day of July 1839, till paid.

At the request of the administrator the commissioner has issued the following receipt Rec^d of Rob^t Richards administrator of Edwin Richards the sum of five hundred and eighty eight dollars and forty cents for my wife's proportion of the estate of Edwin Richards dec^d so far as settled April 20th 1841.
