In the name of God, amen: I, Nancy James of Southampton County and State
of Virginia, do make this my last will and testament in words as follow,
To wit:

1st Item. I give and bequeath unto my son John James the following negroes, namely,
woman Maria, Boy Nathan, girl Sarah, boy Roddick; woman Sarah, boy Peter,
boy Bob, Harry and Jimbick and boy Joshua and there increase to
him and his heirs forever.

2nd Item. I give and bequeath unto my daughter Eliza Parsons my negro
woman Charlotte and girl Narcissa, to her and her heirs forever.

3rd Item. I lend to my daughter Eliza Parsons my negro woman Mary
Emma and girl Tobitha during her life and at her death, I give these
negroes, namely Mary Emma and Tobitha with their increase to the heirs
of Sampson Little.

4th Item. I give and bequeath unto my grand son John Augustus James the
plantation, on which his mother Sally James, now lives, also negro boys decen,
Lefee, girl Lucy, and boy Hattwell, and if he should die before he be-
comes twenty one years old or without a lawful heir, the said plantation
and negroes is to return back to my estate and be divided equally
between my children and Grand children.

5th Item. I give and bequeath unto my grandson Samuel Edward James
the plantation I bought of Calvin A. Scarborough, also negro boy
Dennis, Nicholas, and girl Clementine, and he should die before
he become twenty one years old, or without a lawful heir, the
said plantation and negroes is to return back to my estate
and to be equally divided between my children and Grand children.

6th Item. I lend to my Grand daughter Hester Ann Parsons
my negro girl Bibaramma during her life and at her death the said
negro with her increase to be given to her children.

7th Item. I lend to my Grand daughter Maria Caroline Pleasant my
negro girl Ester during her life, and at her death, the said negro and
increase to be given to her increase.

8th Item. I give and bequeath unto my Grandson John Robert Little
my negro boy Bailey, and if he should die before he becomes twenty one
years old or without a lawful heir the said negro to be returned
