And lastly, I hereby nominate and appoint my said nephew James Holt Executor of this my last will and testament hereby revoking annulling all other wills or testaments by me heretofore made. In witness whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 25th day of January, in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and fifty two.
