Dr. Bailett from his estate his younger sister Mrs. Catharine Bailett rec'd. as for their receipts, I must charge Mrs. Bailett the sum of \$75.00 a little less than 5 per ct. com. To be deducted from the within balance of \$119.89 will leave the whole due from me to her on the estate of \$44.89 which should be placed to my account against her.
