 To the County Court of Southampton County:

Your commissioner reports to the Court that on the 17th day of July last, at the request of Samuel Wells admr. of the estate of Thomas Collier dec'd he appointed Monday the 6th day of Sept^r last, at his office, in the Town of Jerusalem said County for receiving proof of debts or demands against the said dec'd or his estate. And posted a notice of such time and place to the creditors of the said estate, and all others concerned, at the front door of the Court house of said County, on the first day of two successive Terms of the County Court of said County, to-wit: at July and August Terms last.
