Turner, and said accounts having lain with the Clerk of the Court more than thirty days and no exceptions being filed thereto, and confirmed by the Court and ordered to be recorded: and it appearing to the Court from said accounts that there are not sufficient assets in the hands of the said W^m A. Jones adm^r, aforesaid to pay all the debts against the estate of the said James H. Turner dec^d, it is adjudged, ordered & decreed that the said Commissioner apporportion the amount due from the said adm^r amongst the several creditors who have proved their debts as aforesaid, that he ascertain the amount due each and make report thereof to this Court with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself, or which he may be required so to do by either of the parties.

In the name of God, Amen: I, Silas Ellsworth of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, do hereby make and publish this my last will and testament in manner and form following, that is to say:
I Trust 1st After my decease, I desire that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid out of my estate by my executor hereinafter nominated.

2^d I leave to my beloved wife Martha Ann for and during the term of her natural life, my plantation or tract of land whereon I reside with the privilege of using and selling any of the timber thereon. I also leave to her during the said term of her natural life my negro man Tobias.
3^d After the decease of my said wife, I desire that my said plantation or tract of land be sold to the highest bidder on a credit of twelve months, also my said negro man Tobias, on the same credit, and the money arising from the sale of said land and negro man, I give and bequeath as follows: I give to my daughter Maria H. Vink the interest on one fifth part to be paid to her annually during the term of her natural life. And after her decease I give and bequeath the fifth part of the monies aforesaid, to her children to be equally divided between them. I give to my daughter Caroline A. Barnes, the interest on one fifth part to be paid to her annually during the term of her natural life, and after her decease to be equally divided between them, the monies aforesaid to her children. I give the said fifth part of the monies aforesaid to my sons Joseph H. Ellsworth and William H. Ellsworth. I give and bequeath to my daughter Sarah E. Balle, to them and their heirs forever, the third of the monies aforesaid, in the same proportion as mentioned in the third Trust herein.
4th and lastly, I hereby nominate and appoint my friends Daniel Barrett and Harrison S. Pope, Executors of this my last will and testament.
