stated deemed pertinent by himself, or which he may be required
so to do by either of the parties.

In the name of God, Amen! I, Sarah Ellsworth of the County of Southampton
and State of Virginia, do hereby make and publish this my last will and
testament in manner and form following: That is to say:
Item 1st. After my decease, I desire that all my just debts and
funeral expenses be paid out of my estate by my executors hereinafter
nominated.

Item 2^d. I leave to my beloved wife Martha Ann for and during the
term of her natural life, my plantation or tract of land wherein I reside with
privilege of using and selling any of the timber thereon. I also leave to her during
the said term of her natural life, my negro man Sabius.

Item 3^d. After the decease of my said wife, I desire that my said plantation or
tract of land be sold to the highest bidder on a credit of twelve months,
also my said Negroman Sabius, on the same credit, and the money arising
from the sale of said land and negro man, I give and bequeath ^{one fifth part} to
my daughter Maria H. Vick the interest on one fifth part
to be paid to her annually during the term of her natural life. ^{and} after her decease
I give the said fifth part of the money arising ^{one fifth part} to my daughter
Caroline D. Barnes, the interest on one fifth part ^{and} to be paid
to her annually during the term of her natural life, and after her decease
I give the said fifth part of the money arising ^{one fifth part} to my children, to be
equally divided between them. The other three fifths I give and
bequeath to my sons Joseph H. Ellsworth and William H. Ellsworth
and my daughter Sarah E. Biddle, to them and their heirs forever
Item 4th. I give and bequeath all the balance of my estate ^{and} my
children and grand children, in the same proportion as mentioned
in the third item herein.

Item 5th and lastly, I hereby nominate and appoint my friends, Dr.
Barrett and Harrison S. Pepe, Executors of this my last will and
testament.
