Mary & Elizabeth Scott to be equally divided between them and their heirs forever.
3. I do hereby nominate and appoint my friend Drury Drevary Executor to this my
last will and testament hereby revoking all other and former Wills by me heretofore
made. In testimony whereof, I have hereunto affixed my hand and set my seal

A Court held for the County of Southampton the 10th day of August 1854.
This last Will and testament of Mary Scott a. d. was this day proved by
the oath of James D. Maffomburg, one of the subscribing witnesses thereto,
and it appearing to the Court that J. Maffomburg the other subscribing wit-
ness thereto is dead, James D. Maffomburg & E. W. Maffomburg being sworn,
deposed and said that they are well acquainted with the handwriting
of the said J. Maffomburg, and verily believe that the name of the said J.
Maffomburg thereto subscribed, is wholly in the proper handwriting of the said
J. Maffomburg. Whereupon the said last will and testament of the said Mary
Scott dead is ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of Benjamin
Drury the Executor therein named, who made oath and gave bond and
surety according to law. Certificate is granted him for obtaining
a probat of the said will in due form.
